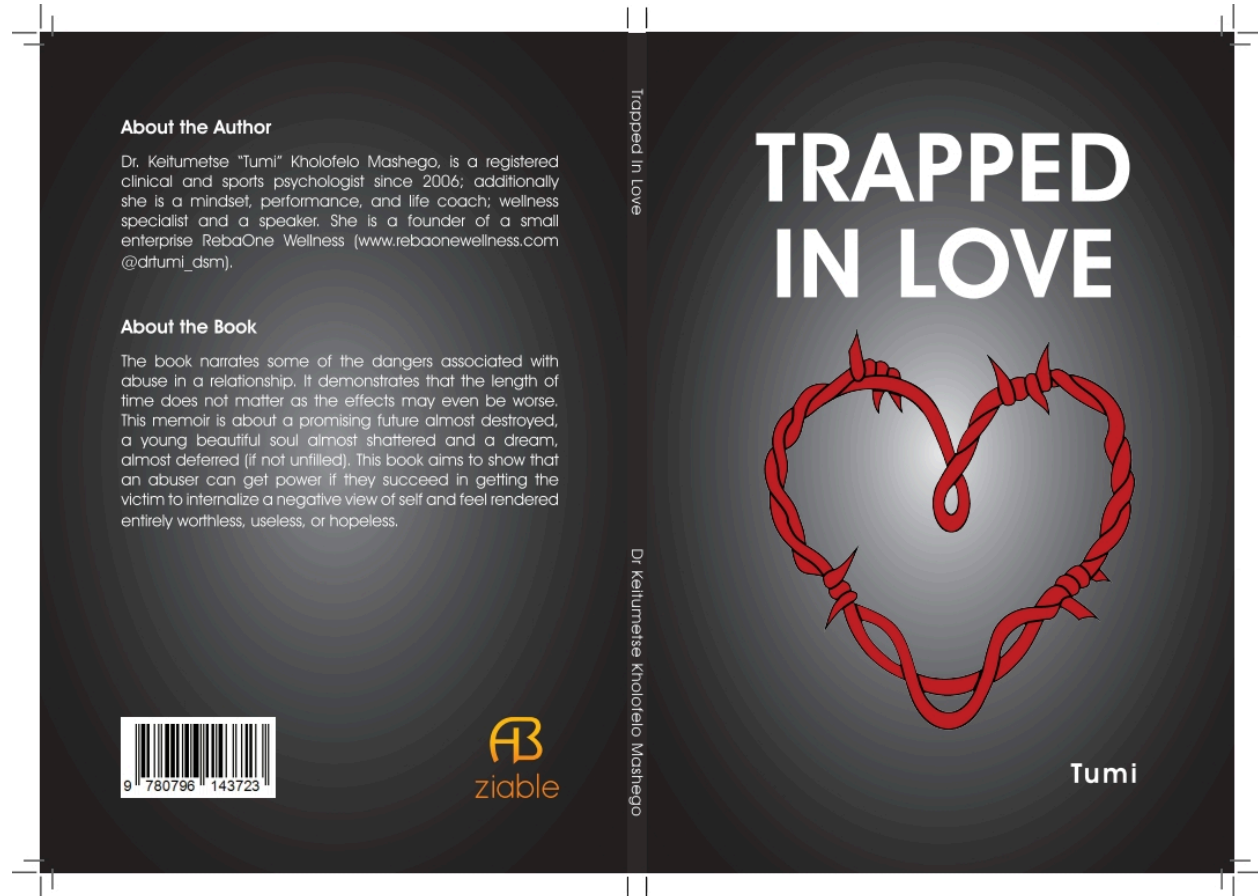


## TRAPPED IN LOVE- MEMOIR REVIEWS.....
